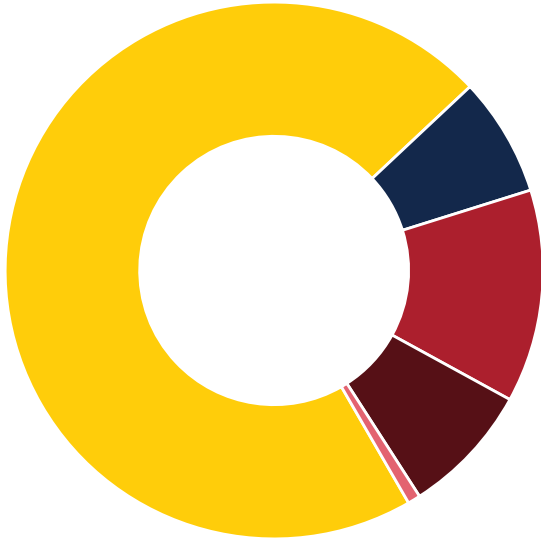

Progress towards Goals

iReady data has consistently demonstrated progress at or above the annual typical growth rate.

ELA test scores have remained relatively flat with a slight dip in 2025. Since 2022, Math state assessment scores increased from 14.9% to 28.7% over the four years.

Attendance at SCPA at German Village has decreased from 84.6% in 2022 to 79.4% in 2025.

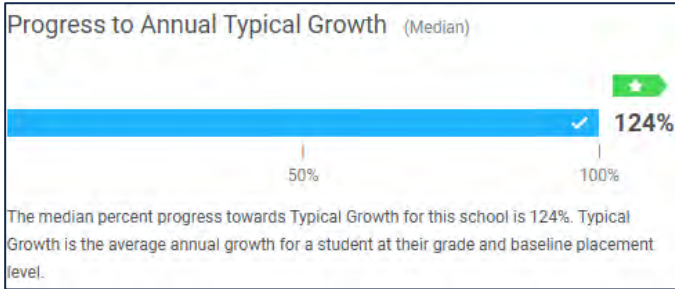

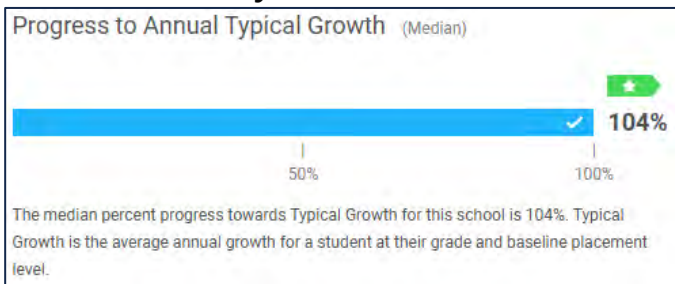
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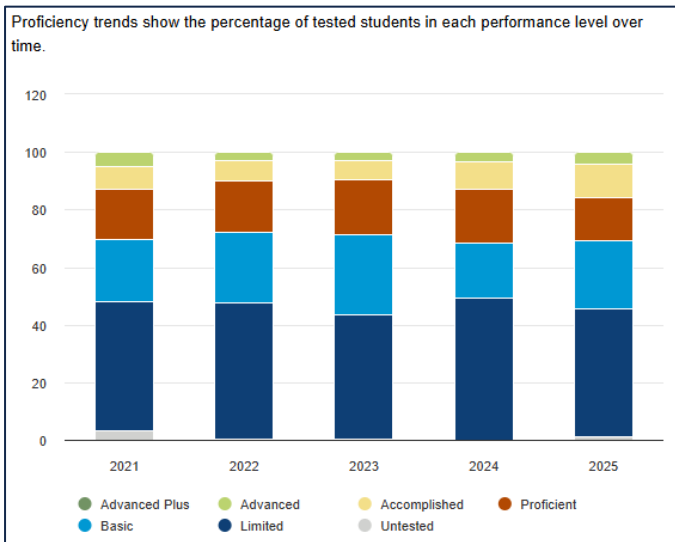
iReady Data Reading
